The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is both an inquiry process and a ritual celebration for adults who desire to embrace the Catholic Faith. It is open to any adult who is unbaptized, baptized in another Faith or baptized Catholic but never fully Catechized (never received further instructions or Holy Eucharist).

The process begins with a period of inquiry where all individuals should feel comfortable to learn more about the Faith before making any further commitment that would lead to being baptized or brought into full Communion in the Catholic Church. If you or anyone you know have any interest in this process (RCIA), please call the Rectory (662-2721).
